Crossman to Receive Pharmacy Technician of the Year Award

Pamela Crossman will be honored by the Michigan Society of Pharmacy Technicians (MSPT) as Technician of the Year. The award will be presented at the Michigan Pharmacists Association (MPA) Annual Convention & Exposition, Feb. 26-28 at the Detroit Marriott at the Renaissance Center.

The Pharmacy Technician of the Year Award is presented annually to an individual employed as a pharmacy technician who has positively contributed to the practice of pharmacy. Crossman was selected Technician of the Year for her long-standing contributions to the pharmacy and patients at Lakeland Health in southwestern Michigan. She is responsible for scheduling, hiring, training and management of the pharmacy technicians and interns.

Crossman first became a member of MSPT in 1971. She was certified as a pharmacy technician in 1981 when she successfully completed the first exam offered to pharmacy technicians anywhere in the country.

Crossman has been active in her community by serving on the Advisory Board of the School of Nursing and Health Sciences for Southwestern Michigan College and the Healthcare Education Institute Advisory Board for Lake Michigan College. She also serves as the pharmacy liaison for all of the EMS agencies of Berrien County.
