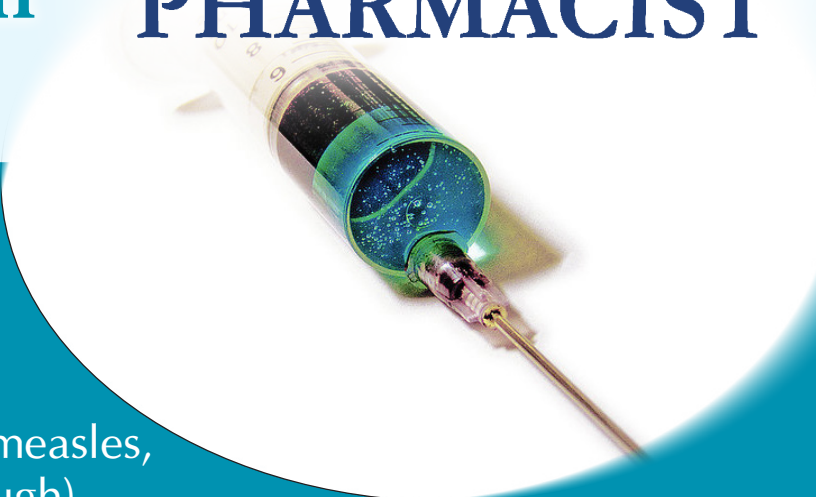

DID YOU KNOW?

- Vaccine-preventable disease occurrences are at an all time low, but outbreaks do occur, especially: measles, mumps and pertussis (whooping cough)
- Children and adolescents should receive all scheduled vaccines to prevent illness
- Adults also need vaccines
- At age 60, insurances usually cover the shingles vaccine
- Pregnant women may need certain vaccines
- Adults traveling out of the country may need vaccines
- Adults who smoke, have diabetes or COPD should get the pneumonia vaccine
