- · HIV is a virus that weakens the body's immune system that defends against diseases.

- · 50,000 Americans get infected with HIV every year.
- There are 1.2 million Americans infected with HIV and many do not know they have become infected.
- · Many drug stores have quick tests you can take to see if you may be infected with HIV.
