MPF Golf Classic Moves to the Inn at St. John's, Plymouth

Once again, golfers will play in a four-person scramble format, with flights for men and mixed teams.

The beauty of the tree-lined fairways is complemented by the panoramic view of one of southeast Michigan's most picturesque landmarks, the Inn at St. John's, formerly a Romanesque seminary.

The yearly spending guideline for grant funding will be a minimum of five percent and up to a maximum of 90 percent of the previous year's fundraising net revenue.
